

LINKS: Supporting grant holders of the Empowering Young People Programme

Performance Report Card 2016-2024



How much did we do?

650 people from 105 organisations attended LINKS events which focused on networking, practice development, impact measurement and sustainability.

427 hours of 1:1 support was provided to 97 organisations covering impact measurement, involvement of young people in project delivery and review and sustainability.

12,253 visits were made to the LINKS support [webpages](#).

How well did we do it?

105 organisations attended at least one LINKS event over the lifetime of the network: 76% of grant holders.

93% very or totally satisfied with the overall support.

68% very or totally satisfied with the support offered regarding the involvement of young people in their projects*.

83% very or totally satisfied with the networking aspects of LINKS events*.

95% very or totally satisfied with the strength and support needs assessment meetings*.

99% indicated workshops met their expectations/objectives**.

88% rated the LINKS support webpages at 6 or above for appearance and 93% rated it 6 or above for content* (1=very poor; 10=excellent)

Is anyone better off?

96% agreed that their knowledge in the subject areas had improved**.

86% agreed that their skills in the subject areas had increased**.

74% agreed that LINKS facilitated the sharing of best practice*.

By the end of LINKS:

72% indicated that they were very successful in involving young people in the design of their project ***.

66% indicated that they were very successful in involving young people in the delivery of their project ***.

72% indicated that they were very successful in involving young people in the review of their project ***.

80% indicated that they often shared learning and best practice with other EYP funded organisations ***.

72% were very confident in using technology and social media to promote learning from their EYP funded project ***.

69% were very confident that their project had the capacity to provide an enduring legacy ***.
