
Making it REAL Lewisham 2021-2024 Evaluation Report - Key Insights



Children show improvement in communication, language and early literacy development and also in their life skills e.g. independence, confidence

EYs settings trained to deliver the home learning programme

47% of EYs settings reached

of practitioners report increased confidence and knowledge in working with parents to support communication and early literacy

1200+ children reached

parents reached 94%

of parents feel confident/very confident supporting their child's learning at home compared to 57% prior to taking part in Making it REAL

Making it REAL has

- **Enhanced** practitioner awareness of the importance of the HLE
- Increased frequency of positive HLE activities
- Enhanced quality of communication offer within settings and in the community
